All juniors must wear an ASTM approved helmet while mounted. There are sheep and loose poultry on this farm, so please leave your dog at home. This show is not sanctioned by any organization or association. No stabling available, but contact Marcie if you have a special need.

Entry Fees are \$10 per class. Championship and Reserve will be awarded in all divisions containing 3 or more classes except game classes. Management will change, split, cancel or add classes as warranted.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

- Introductory Equitation - Ground assistant is allowed and Leadline is permitted.
- Beginner Equitation – Judged on position, control and guidance. Beginners only please.
- Open Equitation - Open to all. Fences not to exceed 2'3".
- Pleasure Hunter – Open to all. Trotting fences is permitted.
- Intermediate Equitation – Open to all. Trotting fences is permitted.
- Sainly Hunter – Open to all. Judged on turn-out, performance, suitability, and safeness. Trotting fences is permitted. Fences not to exceed 2'.
- Hopeful Hunter – Open to all. Fences not to exceed 2'3". Performance, manners, way of going.
- Open Hunter – Open to all. Fences 2'3" to 2'6". Performance, manners, way of going.
- Puddle Jumper – Fences not to exceed 2'3"
- Training Jumper – Fences not to exceed 2'6"
- Break and Out * – Follow announcer's directions or you are out.
- Egg and Spoon * – Riders will carry an egg on a spoon. Last one to drop their egg wins.
- Bareback \$ * – Riders to provide own dollar. Last rider with dollar will win all fallen dollars.
- * \$5 each or \$10 for all three game classes.

DIRECTIONS

From north (Winchester, Harrisonburg): Take Interstate 81 South to Bridgewater/Mt. Crawford, exit 240. Proceed west on 257 (Dinkle Ave.) to Bridgewater. Turn left onto Rt. 42 South (Quarles & Hardee's). Proceed 13 miles (2 miles after Parnassus) and turn left onto Union Church Road (736). Go 1 mile and take first left onto Dudley Farm Road (835). Elk Run Stables is on left after ¾ miles.

From south (Staunton, Lexington, Charlottesville): Take Interstate 81 North to Rt. 262, exit 220. Go 7.5 miles to Churchville Ave (Rt. 250) and turn left. Proceed through Churchville and turn right onto Rt. 42 North (IGA & Tastee Freeze). Proceed 4.5 miles and turn right onto Union Church Road (736). Go 1 mile and take first left onto Dudley Farm Road (835). Elk Run Stables is on left after ¾ miles.
